Angeliquei	Pale Lilac Blue	Flowers are 12-14cm, with light brown anthers.	Produces good fresh green foliage and is very free flowering. Suitable for any aspect. Flowering period early to mid summer, and late summer to early autumn.	1 - 1.2m
Artic Queeni	White	Clear creamy white sepals and yellow anthers. All flowers are double or semi-double 10-17.5cm across.	Extremely long flowering period from early summer to early autumn. The double and sometimes the later, semi-double flowers are produced on both the old, previous season's ripened stems and on the current growth.	3m
Cezannei	Sky Blue	Attractive sky blue single flowers 14 - 17.5cm across, with overlapping sepals and yellow anthers.	Best placed out of full sun to avoid fading the flowers. Flowering period late spring to early summer, and late summer to early autumn.	1 - 1.2m
Chantillyi	White -pink blush.	White flowers with a slight pink blush, the mature flowers are lightly scented.	Flowers from spring to late summer, preferring light shade. Height 90 -120cm, spread 60cm. Prune in spring down to 30cm.	1.2m
Chevalieri	Velvet purple to mid blue.	Velvet purple, star shaped, sepaed flowers ageing to mid blue as they mature	Launched in 2009. An extremely free-flowering clematis. Ideal for combining with silver or golden foliage evergreen shrubs or underplanted with silver foliage perennials in a pot. Height 2m, prune in spring to 30cm.	2m
Crystal Fountaini	Lilac Blue	Lilac-blue double flowers, 12.5-15cm across, with a dramatic fountain like centre which is paler in colour. The early flowers can be mauve-blue with a green central bar to each sepal	Flowering period late spring to early summer, and late summer to early autumn. Flowers on both old and current season's growth.	1.5-2m
Diana's Delighti	Blue	Unusual blue coloured flowers with light and dark tones and creamy yellow centre.	Launched in 2009, very free flowering habit, early mid summer then late summer early autumn. Height 2m, prune in spring to 30cm.	2m
Empressi	Light Pink	Double flowers, pink outer sepals have a darker pink bar; narrow inner sepals give spiky pom-pom effect. Flowers 12-15cm across.	An extraordinary-looking clematis, developed as a sport from C. Josephine. Always produces its double flowers, from both old and new growth. Flowering period late spring to early summer, and early autumn.	1.5-2m
Fleuri	Deep purple red	Velvety flowers are a deep purple-red with a central bar 12-15cm across, very freeflowering. It has a large boss of creamy white anthers on red filaments. Colour is similar to that of Picardy.	A strong coloured plant that performs extremely well. It is very uniform in its habit flowering down the stems. Flowering period early to mid summer.	1 - 1.2m
Franziska Mariai	Blue Purple	Beautifully shaped, mid-blue purple flowers with yellow anthers, always double or semi-double 10-15cm across.	Extremely free-flowering plant. It always produces double or semi-double flowers, the fully double flowers being produced from the ripened stems of the previous season. Flowering period late spring to early summer, and late summer to early autumn.	2-2.5m
Ice Bluei	White	The white early flowers are 15-20cm in diameter, are suffused with pale blue giving it a true 'ice blue' colour. The sepals are offset by creamy white anthers.	Launched at the 2006 Chelsea Flower show. An extremely free flowering plant, it is both very early flowering and very late flowering. Produces flowers down its stem. It will flower at a low height from the previous seasons growth and is therefore particularly suited to containers and the small garden.	2-2.5m
Josephinei	Lilac with Pink Bar	Early summer flowers will have a greenish, muddy bronze colouring, then, as the season develops the colour becomes lilac with a pink bar. The inner sepals open more slowly giving the flower a layered pom-pom effect.	Exceptional double-flowered clematis because of the number of flowers produced, long flowering period and unusual flower shape. Flowers on both old and current seasons growth.	2.5m
Kingfisheri	Blue Purple	Very large flowers 15 - 17.5cm wide, of intense blue pointed sepals with creamy yellow anthers.	Launched at the 2007 Chelsea Flower Show, extremely free flowering habit, flowering down its stem. Does not fade in the sun, and is therefore ideal for any location or aspect. A very versatile clematis for the small garden. Flowering period is late spring to early summer and again in late summer to early autumn.	2-2.5m
Ooh La Lai	Pink-striped	Delicate dusky pink-striped flowers 10-12.5cm across, made up of six to eight pointed frilly edged sepals. The sepals have a darker central band with contrasting dark red anthers.	Free flowering plant which is uniform in habit with attractive light green foliage. A very free flowering plants which is uniform in habit.	1 - 1.2m
Parisiennei	Violet Blue	Pale, violet-blue flowers, 12-14cm across, with overlapping waxy-edged sepals and attractive red anthers.	A rather typical blue clematis with a red centre, but the sheer volume of flowers it produces makes it a very valuable garden plant. Flowering period late spring to early summer, and late summer to early autumn.	1 - 1.2m
Picardy	Dusky Red	Dusky red flowers are 12.5-15cm with a brighter red bar on the sepals and reddish brown anthers.	A truly outstanding plant, extremely well-flowered. Superb in a container or in a border, and exceptionally good for a small garden with limited room. Flowering period early to mid summer, and late summer to early autumn.	1 - 1.2m
Rebecca	Outstanding new red	Deep velvety red flowers 15-20cm across, with light chocolate brown stamens.	Launched at the 2008 Chelsea Flower show, this outstanding, new, red clematis is very free flowering, has large flowers and flowers down its stem. Flowering period late spring to early summer, and late summer to early autumn.	2-2.5m
Rosemoori	Red Purple	Clematis Rosemoor has good strong red/purple flowers.	Good repeat flowering habit and long flowering season from early to late summer. Useful for container or garden planting. Height 2 - 2.5m. Light prune in early spring.	2.5m
